# 74VCXH16374 Low Voltage 16-Bit D-Type Flip-Flop with Bushold

#### **General Description**

The VCXH16374 contains sixteen non-inverting D-type flipflops with 3-STATE outputs and is intended for bus oriented applications. The device is byte controlled. A buffered clock (CP) and output enable  $(\overline{\text{OE}})$  are common to each byte and can be shorted together for full 16-bit operation.

The VCXH16374 data inputs include active bushold circuitry, eliminating the need for external pull-up resistors to hold unused or floating data inputs at a valid logic level.

The 74VCXH16374 is designed for low voltage (1.65V to 3.6V)  $V_{CC}$  applications with output compatibility up to 3.6V.

The 74VCXH16374 is fabricated with an advanced CMOS technology to achieve high speed operation while maintaining low CMOS power dissipation.






### **Functional Description**

The 74VCXH16374 consists of sixteen edge-triggered flip-The 74VCXH16374 consists of sixteen edge-triggered flip-flops with individual D-type inputs and 3-STATE true out-puts. The device is byte controlled with each byte function-ing identically, but independent of the other. The control pins can be shorted together to obtain full 16-bit operation. Each clock has a buffered clock and buffered Output Enable common to all flip-flops within that byte. The description which follows applies to each byte. Each flip-

flop will store the state of their individual I inputs that meet the setup and hold time requirements on the LOW-to-HIGH Clock  $(CP_n)$  transition. With the Output Enable  $(\overline{OE}_n)$  LOW, the contents of the flip-flops are available at the outputs. When  $\overline{\text{OE}}_n$  is HIGH, the outputs go to the high impedance state. Operations of the  $\overline{\rm OE}_{\rm n}$  input does not affect the state of the flip-flops.




