



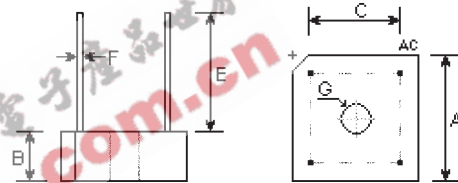

Fig. 1 – MAXIMUM FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

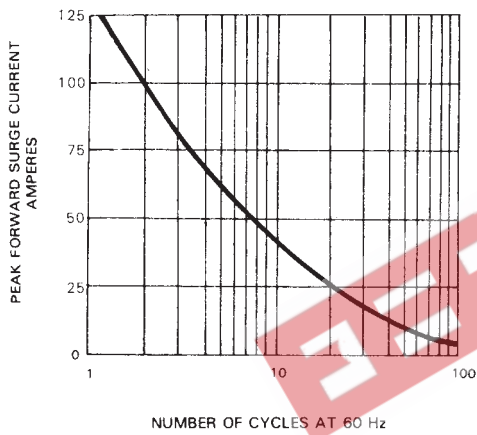


Fig. 2 – DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

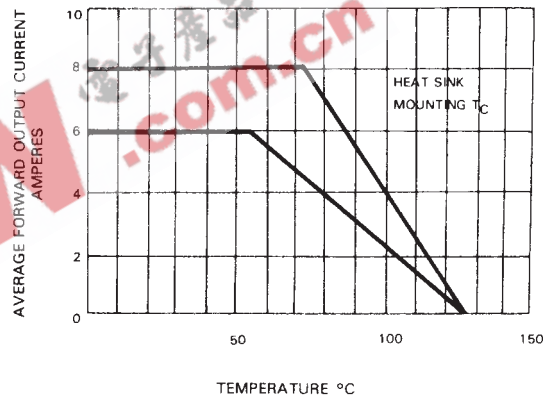


Fig. 3 – TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

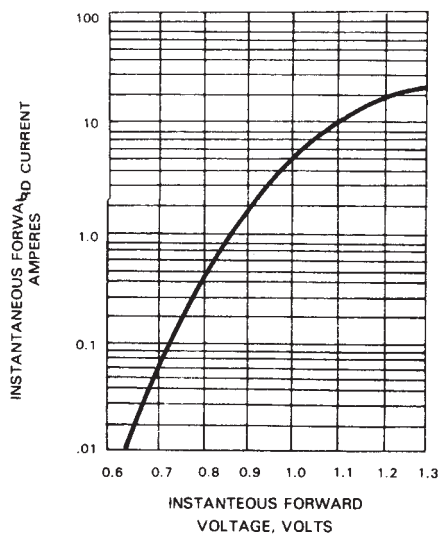


Fig. 4 – TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
