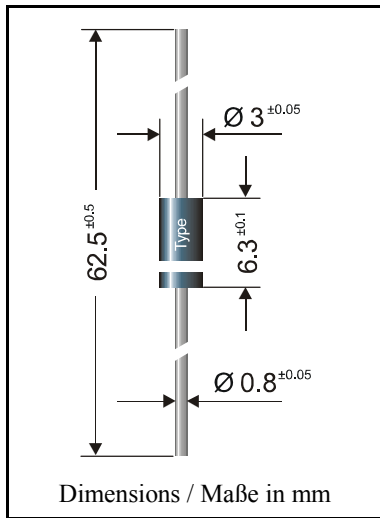

The order of type numbers is graded to the international E 24 standard. The standard tolerance of the breakdown voltage for each type is $\pm 10\%$. Suffix “A” denotes a tolerance of $\pm 5\%$.

e.g.: P6KE160CA = bidirectional diode, $V_{BR} = 160 \text{ V } (\pm 5\%)$, $V_{WM} \geq 136 \text{ V}$ at $I_D = 5 \mu\text{A}$
P6KE7.5A = unidirectional diode, $V_{BR} = 7.5 \text{ V } (\pm 5\%)$, $V_{WM} \geq 6.4 \text{ V}$ at $I_D = 500 \mu\text{A}$
